NEP Energy Services (NEPes) is a charity-owned social enterprise, working across the UK from our base in Nottingham. Our mission is to devise, manage and deliver effective practical projects tackling fuel poverty, reducing carbon emissions and improving resource efficiency. We have 10 years experience turning national targets into warm homes, healthy communities and sustainable workplaces.

NEPes work across all sectors to build partnerships and deliver programmes. With partner agencies we work to alleviate fuel poverty, cut carbon emission and educate the public about energy efficiency, ensuring that those most in need achieve affordable warmth and a better quality of life.

Within smaller businesses, immediate savings are critical. NEPes has extensive experience of supporting businesses in finding quick cost and carbon savings then helping to cascade benefits and knowledge out to staff, service users and the local community.

NEP is a charity and 100% of NEPes profits are recycled into local community carbon and fuel poverty projects.

As such, for every four days of consultancy purchased from us by a private sector or large organisation, we gift one day of free support to a local community. As a voluntary organisation, if we are working with a client in your area, we could potentially support you for free.

We have received two major international awards for our work with Organisations. The 2011 International Green Award for Best Green Not-For-Profit Organisation and the 2011 British Medical Journal global Award for Sustainable Healthcare.

Our non-domestic team offers support for private, public and third sector organisations. What We Do

We work with a specialist SME switching provider, our team of local surveyors and survey partners, local universities and local suppliers to provide an end to end service that ensures independent advice, local connections and support to achieve real cost and carbon savings; while creating and protecting business, revenue and jobs in the local economy.

Our aim is to work with SMEs to reduce environmental impacts and help grow a thriving local green and low carbon economy. We currently operate a full service across Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire; however we offer energy surveys and some consulting services nationally.

We employ a growing number of staff and support an increasing number of businesses, however we do not have shareholders or offer bonuses and carry out this work primarily to meet our environmental and social aims.

A huge number of businesses with tight budgets are paying too much for their energy. This is money unnecessarily unnecessarily diverted from your bottom line.

NEPes work with Nottingham-based Torse in supporting the businesses to save money by finding the right energy tariff. NEP is totally independent, however we earn a small commission, whoever you switch to. Businesses qualify for free desktop energy bill analysis.

While many businesses want to save money immediately, tariff switching does not save carbon and costs can creep up again. We work to ensure that cost and carbon savings are lasting and have a wider beneficial impact by referring businesses to other local services, and identify whether they could benefit from investing in energy efficiency or environmental management.



Save and Generate

Many energy and carbon savings can be achieved by low cost or no cost interventions. To achieve carbon and cost reductions, site specific work is required to identify, evaluate and deliver savings.

NEPes offer a range of energy efficiency surveys to businesses, designed to help reduce their energy costs and carbon emissions while freeing up capital, which can be reinvested in service provision. Ranging from basic legislative compliance through to identification of a complete package of investment measures NEPes is able to help businesses of any size to reduce the environmental impact of their activities.

Once all cost effective energy efficiency measures have been implemented, you could consider generating your own energy. Feed in Tariffs and the Renewable Heat Incentive can make renewable energy a secure source of unrestricted income for the next 20 years.

iiE offers a low-cost, minimum bureaucracy process to achieve a credible Environmental Management System as part of a process of continual improvement.

Key features of iiE:

- The iiE mark helps you target and achieve bill savings that can be reinvested in service provision.
- An accredited EMS is a mark of commitment to good environmental management.
- Access support and guidance on environmental issues, legislation and business opportunities.
- The iiE mark is an accessible, non-bureaucratic EMS aimed at small organisations, but is equally valid for large organisations, setting an example for their supply chain, or to show community leadership.
- The iiE mark enables businesses to become part of a supported local green network.
- The iiE mark is simpler, quicker and cheaper than other recognised systems. This allows clients to demand good environmental management, without discriminating against SMEs.
